

JATOBA'

Exposure to light causes the wood to darken unevenly over time; for this reason, at the time of supply, the wood elements may have a different color. This is not a technical defect but an aesthetic feature of Jatobà. If customers seek a "uniform" effect, this wood is not suitable; but if they appreciate variability and naturalness, this feature becomes an added value.

Color: It varies from orange-red to brownish-red, with darker stripes.

Origin: Caribbean countries of Central America and South America, particularly Brazil.

Features of the trunks: The tree is large, reaching 40-50m high. The trunk has extensive buttresses at the base, above which the diameter can reach 1.5 m or more.

Internal use: flooring, parquet, stairs, window frames, doors, cladding, furniture.

External use: garden furniture, outdoor structures, facade cladding, and decking.
